## ACCOMMODATION INFORMATION

Quite a number of rooms have either a small balcony overlooking a central courtyard with plantings, trees and a fish pond, or a larger one looking over the University Campus, lots of trees, birds and architecture. Quiet and sedate. The Twentieth Century Heritage Society has stayed at this venue on a number of occasions and has always enjoyed the ambiance and the rather good rates. We would not think of any other hotel in Canberra, although we do appreciate that if you are on a loyalty programme with an International Hotel that would be your first choice.

Please Note the following Room Rates:

We have "Reserved" a number of Rooms of differing configuration, however there is flexibility (We can add more), we just need to know from you at your earliest opportunity. You can book the accommodation along with the Programme Registration, however if you arrange it directly you need to ensure that the booking staff at University House know that you are part of the Twentieth Century Heritage Society of NSW's Pre Congress Programme.

The Rates are essentially 'Per Room Per Night' with a small surcharge for the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> Guest which covers the extras such as towels and essentials.
