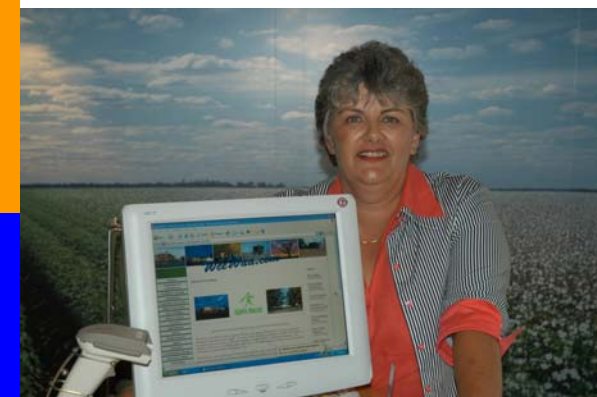

Many websites are run by community groups and not for profit organizations where it is run as a charity and rely on voluntary work. This then lags behind and pages are not kept up to date. Other companies offer similar packages and give people the opportunity to set up their own little webpage within the site. Who wants to visit a website with empty pages that gives them no information at all. Rather than empty pages you can run an ad about their company and keep it updated for them.
